PERSONAL CONDUCT

The Malone Central School District believes that interscholastic athletics serve the purpose of fostering leadership, respect, teamwork, discipline, and sportsmanship. As a result, members of District athletic teams are expected to behave in a manner that reflects these values. Behavior that undermines these values or disrupts the operation of the District's academic or athletic program is prohibited, whether it is engaged in on-campus, off-campus, or online.

Displays of sportsmanship and respect are not limited to the playing field. Student-athletes will not engage in on-campus, off-campus or online behavior that threatens or is hostile to fellow students, faculty, staff, teammates, coaches, officials, or opponents.

In the event a student-athlete is arrested, a committee comprised of the Director of Athletics, the building principal, and the student-athlete's coaches will be convened to determine whether there is competent and substantial proof that interscholastic athletics policies have been violated and what penalty, if any, should be assessed.
